The City of Dowagiac is seeking sealed bids from waste disposal contractors for its ANNUAL SPRING CLEAN-UP WEEK.

Bids will be received until 3:00 p.m. EST, Thursday, March 30, 2017, at the Dowagiac City Hall, P.O. Box 430, 241 South Front Street, Dowagiac, Michigan 49047; at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids must be clearly marked in the lower left-hand corner of the envelope as "SPRING CLEAN-UP WEEK BID".

## 2017 SPRING CLEAN-UP PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS: General Provisions

### **Project Description**

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The Contractor shall furnish all labor and equipment necessary for collection, compaction, and transportation of all curbside refuse within City limits during the week of April 24<sup>th</sup> through 28<sup>th</sup>.

### **Project Bidding and Contract Award**

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Bids shall be submitted using the units listed below (see Payment).

No bids may be withdrawn for a period of thirty (30) days.

The Contractor shall furnish the City with proof of liability and Workmen's compensation insurance coverage within 10 days after notification of award.

The City reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids, and to waive any irregularities or informalities deemed to be in the best interests of the City.

### **Project Execution**

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The Contractor shall conduct operations in accordance with the schedule and guidelines set forth in Attachment A, *Spring Clean-Up Public Notice Announcement*.

The Contractor shall canvass all streets and residential units throughout the City as shown on the attached Attachment B, *Street Map*. The Contractor shall divide the City into quadrants for canvassing on each of the four days of operations. The Contractor shall make one final collection review run throughout the entire City before concluding operations.

A map and schedule must be provided to the City one week after notification of award, and at least 3 weeks before commencing operations.

The Contractor must furnish at least one twenty cubic yard (20 cu. yd.) roll-off container in a central location for drop-off of items by City residents during the week.

### **Materials Disposal**

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The Contractor shall take possession of all refuse and dispose of it in a manner complying with all pertinent legal requirements and regulations.

### **Payment**

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Payment shall be made as follows: (1) on a per hour (\$/hr) basis for all labor and equipment; (2) on a per ton basis (\$/ton) for collected refuse; and (3) on a per each basis for roll-off containers. Payment for disposal of material placed in roll-offs shall be made at the contract unit price for refuse disposal.

All other expenses required to perform the work, including transportation and fuel expenses and or surcharges, are incidental to the contract unit price for all items.



## **SPRING CLEAN-UP WEEK** **APRIL 24 – APRIL 28, 2017**

### **CITY OF DOWAGIAC DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICES**

**\*\*\*\*\*All materials must be placed curbside prior to 6:00 a.m. Monday, April 24, 2017\*\*\*\*\***

The following restrictions apply to all disposed materials:

1. Refuse must be neatly placed curbside in an orderly fashion.
2. No refrigerators, freezers, or air conditioners will be accepted; unless certification sticker is placed on item indicating that the freon has been removed.
3. No household garbage will be accepted.
4. No individual item over 5' long, 3' wide, or 3' high, weighing over 100 lbs will be accepted.
5. No automotive/marine batteries will be accepted.
6. No tires or rims will be accepted.
7. No materials that are prohibited from disposal in TYPE II landfills (paints, solvents, oils, etc.) will be accepted. (Note: Paint cans that are open and contain only DRY paint will be accepted.)
8. No propane cylinders will be accepted.
9. All construction / demolition material must be less than one cubic yard in total volume for curbside pickup.
10. No lawnmowers or small engines will be accepted unless the gasoline has been completely drained.
11. Total curbside volume shall not exceed 3 cubic yards.
12. Windows, glass, and mirrors must be less than 3' x 4' in size.

**EACH STREET WILL BE SCHEDULED FOR PICK-UP ONE TIME ONLY.**

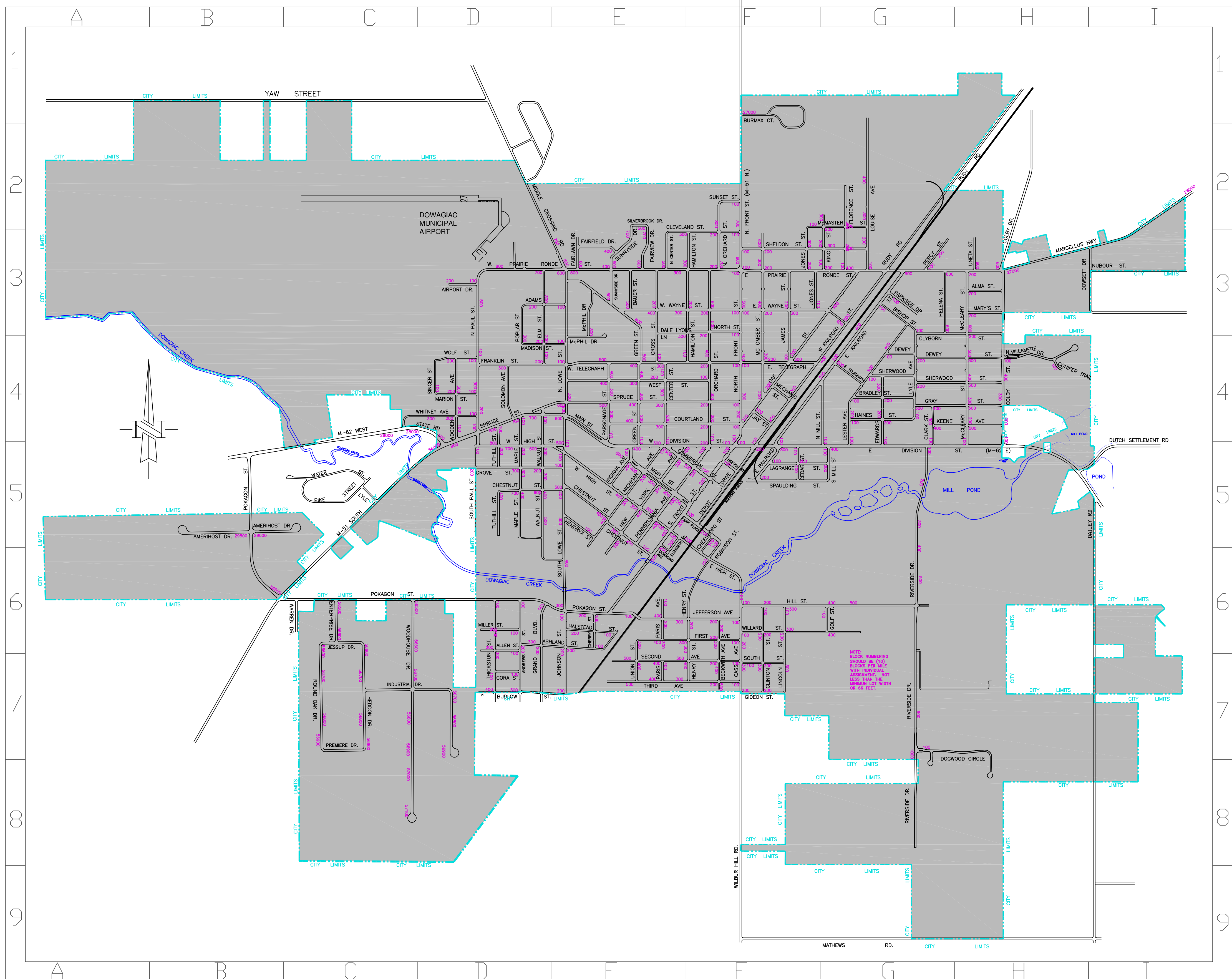
To minimize blighting effects within our neighborhoods, **debris may not be placed curbside prior to Saturday, April 22, 2017.** Violators will be subject to penalties as prescribed by the City's Blight Ordinance.

Property owners will be responsible for clean up and removal of any remaining debris **AFTER** pick up crews have passed through their neighborhood.
